Panora State Bank opened its doors with \$100,000 in capital and with a first board of directors comprised of the following: Dr. C.A. Nicholl; H.W. "Bill" Baldwin; John Donahey; Harley Erb; Glenn Kerr; Murle Mills; E.S. Petersen; and Arthur S. Wood. The first officers of the bank were Dr. C.A. Nicoll, President; Glen Kerr, Vice President; D. A. Murphy, Cashier; and E.S. Petersen, Exec. Vice President. Two of the bank's first employees were Ruby Gilson and Robert E. Petersen.

The first calendar year ending 12/31/1959 assets of the bank were \$634,000. Fifty years later the bank has \$53,000,000 in total assets.

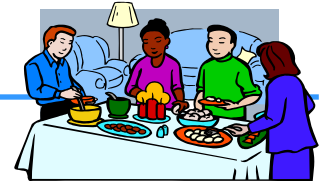
